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Round:

World Record Status WA18, shot to World Archery/ArcheryGB rules.

Eligible for target awards.

It is assumed that all compound and recurve archers will shoot 3-spot targets and all Barebow and longbow archers will shoot single spot faces. If you wish to shoot a different face to this (e.g. Barebow on a 3-spot) please make a note on your entry and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

The bosses at NFP are made of damage.

Registration:

Registration and Equipment inspection will start approximately 30 minutes prior to the scheduled session start time. Where all archers are present and all equipment has been inspected prior to the advertised start time, archers will be given the option to start the session early.

All competitors will be asked to present proof of Archery GB membership at registration/equipment inspection.

Archers are asked not to enter the main shooting venue until the previous session have finished shooting due to space. There is a small area next to the shooting venue where people can wait/set up if needed.

Clothing:

Competitors' clothing must conform to Archery GB Rules of Shooting, rule 307.

Catering:

Light refreshments of tea/coffee/juice and cake will be available to purchase over the weekend. There are nearby shops and cafés for anyone needing something more substantial.

Awards:

Awards will be given to the following categories (depending on entries).

Open 50+; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Female 50+; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Open Senior; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Female Senior; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Open Junior; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Female Junior; Barebow, Compound, Longbow and Recurve

Junior Age group awards may be given depending on entries
